CAPTAIN G. R. THOMAS

We report with regret the sudden and tragic death of Captain George Ronald Thomas which occurred during the night of 28th September.

He joined the Clan Line on 20th August, 1930, as a 4th Officer. He served afloat during the Second World War and was 2nd Officer of the *Clan MacTavish* when she was sunk by enemy action in October, 1942.

Promoted to Chief Officer on 4th July, 1944, he served in the s.s. *Sambali* until transferred to the s.s. *Clan Lamont* as Troop Officer for a series of voyages from the United Kingdom to Poland from October, 1945, to October, 1947.

June, 1955, saw his appointment to the command of the *Clan Macfadyen*. His last ship, the *Klipbok*—formerly s.s. *Umtata*—was strike-bound at London and Captain Thomas was waiting for sailing orders at the time of his death.

Captain Thomas, who was 54, leaves a widow and two sons, one of whom is at present serving as a 3rd Officer with the Company.
