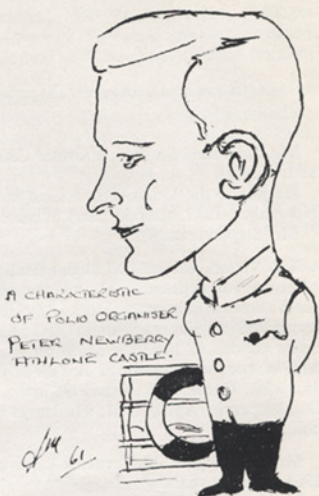

Steamers' Collections

Nearly every voyage of the Mail and Intermediate vessels collections are made on board at Church services and other functions, some of which go to a general fund for distribution to various seamen's charities, hospitals and orphanages in South and East Africa and the United Kingdom. Other collections are specially allocated to particular organisations and purposes by the ships themselves. During 1960 a total of nearly £25,000 was collected on the various ships and nearly £1,000 of this was distributed to local organisations, including the Children's Hospital, Chest Hospital, Missions to Seamen, Sailors' Home and the Talbot House Residential Boys' Club.
