Autumn in the Mediterranean

Following the successful Easter cruise of the *Braemar Castle*—an insight into which can be gleaned elsewhere in the Magazine—(two further Mediterranean Excursions, each of three weeks' duration, have been arranged for the late autumn.

On the earlier cruise passengers will embark at Southampton on 21st October and return to Marseilles on 9th November, having visited Tangier, Palermo, Athens, Beirut, Heraklion and Naples.

The second cruise will commence at Marseilles on 11th November, calling at Naples, Syracuse, Athens, Haifa, Rhodes, Palma and Gibraltar, arriving at London for disembarkation on 3rd December.
