"HOW PROUD WE MUST ALL BE. . ."

Readers will recall the bravery of Chief Engineer Stanley Logan who, despite intense pain, stayed at his post and thought only of saving his ship and the lives of those aboard her when there was a serious explosion in the engine room of the *Capetown Castle* in October, 1960.

We recorded in the October, 1962, edition that his gallantry had been recognised by the posthumous award of the Albert Medal and this was presented by Her Majesty the Queen to Mrs. Pamela Logan, who was accompanied by her daughter Patricia and foster-daughter Daphne Brown, at a private audience before the Investiture at Buckingham Palace.

Mrs. Logan recalls: "The Queen told me that she had read with great interest about my husband's bravery and said how proud we must all be of him."
