B.E.M. FOR RETIRED SEAMAN

Warmest congratulations to Mr. Richard Harding, whose award of the British Empire Medal (Civil Division) was Gazetted in June.

Mr. Harding, who spent 40 of his 48 years at sea with the Union-Castle Line, retired last December.

He joined *Kenibworth Castle* as a Trimmer in June, 1917, when the ship was engaged in troop-carrying. Sailing in convoy, she caused no little excitement when her coal bunkers caught fire—a blaze which lasted for almost 3 days.

Mr. Harding served afloat throughout the Second World War and, in *Durban Castle*, took part in the Sicily and Salonica landings. At the end of hostilities he held the 1939-45 Star, The Africa Star, The Italy Star and the Atlantic Star, in addition to the 1914-18 Star and the General Service Star previously awarded.

In June, 1959, Mr. Harding was promoted to Petty Officer (Leading Hand) on board *Pretoria Castle*; he transferred in August, 1962, to *Windsor Castle* as Donkeyman, a position he held until retirement.
