



Up the "Ditch"

We reported in our last issue the berthing of the Argyllshire at Stanlow. Whilst there the Clan Maciver passed on passage from Manchester to Liverpool and was photographed by Mr. P. S. Coultas. The vessels in the background of the left-hand picture are tankers berthed in Stanlow Oil Docks. Two subways provided with pipes and all other facilities carry the oil underneath the Ship Canal into tank installations on the south side, and vessels up to 560 ft. overall length can be swung in the basin at the entrance to the oil docks
