The cargo liner *Clan Macgregor* was launched by Mrs. A. H. Gurr, wife of a Director of Clan Line Steamers, at the Carlsdyke Shipyards of The Greenock Dockyard Company on 26th September, 1962.

The third vessel to bear the name, the *Clan Macgregor* is the sixty-first ship to be built by the Dockyard for the Clan Line Group of Companies and she is the second of three sister ships built or building for the King Line Ltd.
